Gerald "Jerry" H. Trautman, former chairman and president of the Greyhound Corp., currently known as Viad Corp., died Monday . He was 87. Mr. Trautman, who was born in Petoskey, Mich., became president of Greyhound Corp. in 1966. A Harvard Law School graduate, Mr. Trautman was vice president and general counsel with the company for three years before taking the reins. Mr. Trautman helped transform Greyhound from mainly a bus transportation service to a Fortune 500 company. In 1970, he acquired Armour & Co., which was followed up by the acquisition of smaller service businesses. The following year, Mr. Trautman moved the corporate headquarters from Chicago to Phoenix, making Greyhound the largest publicly held company in the state. "In those days conglomerates were the rage," John Teets, former chairman of Greyhound, Dial and Viad said. "He acquired about 75 companies, one being Armour. I think this was visionary," Teets said. By 1980, Greyhound had revenues of more than \$5 billion. "He was a great man to work with," L. Gene Lemon, who was vice president and general counsel for Greyhound, said. "Certainly, he was the architect of all of Greyhound's success." Mr. Trautman retired in 1982. He continued to serve as a member of the Greyhound board and executive committee after his retirement. In 1980, he was awarded the National Conference of Christians and Jews' National Brotherhood and Humanitarian Award. Mr. Trautman graduated from Stanford University in 1934, where he played on both the golf and baseball teams. He turned down a chance to try out for a major league baseball team and chose to attend law school. "He was a tall, good-looking guy," Teets said. The two met in 1965 at the World's Fair in New York. "He was a great golfer," Teets said. "That's one of the reasons why I think that he moved to Arizona." Mr. Trautman also served in the Navy in World War II. Criminal Justice Planning Advisory Commission. "His life was Arizona," said Mr. Sullivan's daughter, Dede Areghini. "He loved this state."

Mr. Sullivan served on the board of directors of the Maricopa County Bar Association, was state deputy of the Knights of Columbus, and a past president of the SIERRA Club. In addition to his daughter, Mr. Sullivan is survived by his sons, John J., Kevin L. and Mark stepmother, Ethel F. three grandchildren and one great-grandchild. JOSEPH RICHARDS, ARIZ. HISTORIAN, EX-LAWMAKER

Joseph "J." Morris Richards, a former state senator from Navajo County and an Arizona historian, died Jan. 5 in Orem, Utah. He was 92.

A conservative Democrat, Sen. Richards served three terms in the Senate, from 1957 to 1963. "As a senator, he understood the state and knew its problems," former Senate President Stan Turley said. "He was a dedicated Arizonan and loved the history here." Sen. Richards spent 11 years compiling a 20-volume history of the Legislature from 1911 - just before statehood - through 1966.

Although the records have not been published, the 10,000 pages he compiled are kept in the State Library and Archives on microfiche.

Sen. Richards was born Oct. 18, 1906, in Joseph City, Ariz., the fourth of 11 children. In 1929, he received a bachelor's degree in education from Northern Arizona Teachers College, which became Northern Arizona University. He earned a master's degree in education and English from the University of Arizona.

He began working as a reporter and news editor at the weekly Winslow Daily Mail in 1929. After serving in the Army during World War II, Sen. Richards returned to Winslow and became publisher of the Daily Mail in 1947. He retired in 1965 when he became a professor at Brigham Young University's Communications Department.

At BYU, Sen. Richards served as chairman of the department for five years, retiring in 1975. He was a visiting mass communications professor at Arizona State University for three years. Sen. Richards wrote many books on Arizona history, including Unflinching Courage, which dealt with the genealogy of Joseph City and was co-authored by Adele Bushman Westover. Sen. Richards also was director of Western Savings and Loan Association from 1937 to 1987. "He was active all of his life," his widow, Aloa Dixon Richards, said Saturday. In addition to his widow, Sen.
